RUSH Worship Team Expectations

As with any other area of leadership within our church family, this one comes with expectations and responsibilities. Please read these through thoughtfully with your parents.

Lifestyle

As leaders within RUSH, you have committed to keep your lives centered on Christ, allowing the Spirit to make you more like Jesus, and letting God love this world through you. To be this kind of example is a high calling. Not one of perfection, but one of humility. It is a privilege, and if we have questions or concerns about your conduct that we cannot work out with you, we do reserve the right to remove you from the team until we believe you are ready to resume that position again.

Like we said, we do not expect perfection, but we do want to see hearts that chase after Jesus. So, we will be touching base with you frequently to see what we can do to encourage you or how we can specifically pray for you. We are here to help you in whatever way we can!

Ability

As a musician, you will be expected to know how to play your instrument, and be faithfully practicing and working to improve your skills. As a vocalist, you will be expected to be able to sing on-key and have good tonal quality. In whatever we do, we want to give our best to the Lord.

Communication

You will be expected to log into Planning Center and keep up with texts/FB/emails, as these will be the means to let you know when you are scheduled/what songs we are singing at RUSH, and any other important information you will need to know or respond to.

Practice

You will be expected to learn and know the songs WELL by the time we meet for practice. You are responsible for using Planning Center to practice the songs in the appropriate keys.

You are required to be at practice (and please be punctual) on RUSH Wednesdays at 5:15 PM when you are scheduled or you will not have the privilege of leading worship at that week's RUSH meeting. This time is not only for us to practice our music, but to worship together through prayer, spend time in the Word and encouraging one another to live our lives in such a way that brings glory to God. In addition to these weekly practices, there will be practice once each month for everyone. We will do this throughout the summer.

Faithfulness

To be a part of the RUSH Worship Team, you will need to be a "wholehearted" participant in RUSH, both large group and small group nights. That means you will not only make 3 out of 4 meetings, but that you will also invest in the lives of the students around you and engage in the lessons being taught.
