Lesson Overview

Over the course of the RUSH year, we have heard several great testimonies of how God has dramatically changed people’s lives. Tonight is a chance to hear from some of our students, whose testimonies may seem a bit “boring” by comparison. But as you will hear, their faith journeys are far from boring. Pastor JR will drive home the following points, as it relates to “boring” testimonies:

- Baggage and pain comes with “exciting” testimonies.
- No matter their journey with God, everyone struggles with something.
- Just because someone grew up in a Christian environment does not make them saved.
- Finally - There is no such thing as a boring testimony!

The truth is that if we are saved, we have all been brought from eternal death and separation from God to eternal life with God. There is absolutely nothing boring about that!

Discussion Questions

1. Did you feel you could relate to any of their stories? Why/Why not?
2. A common theme throughout their stories was that they thought they were saved at a young age, yet something happened later on in their lives that made them question their salvation.
 - Do you think it’s good to question your salvation? Why/Why not?
 - Have you had moments like that in your life? What did that look like?
